


IMAP: A CEMETERY'S PATH TO PROFESSIONALISM

IMAP is the most versatile GIS mapping product available today. Using it in your daily business affairs will not only maintain the inventory records, but your visitors will be “wowed” with your professionalism. No more getting up to find maps; they are right there on the screen in full color....instantly available. Locating a grave, printing a map for customer direction and identifying available spaces close by is just the beginning.

You can create as many different maps and reports as you wish. A single click in Nexus *automatically updates* all of them, meaning that they are always current. IMAP is normally integrated into our database management system Nexus XP, but it can also be linked to other databases or be used as a stand alone product. In the latter case MBS can create one or more customized front end data entry screens from which to enter information. Let's start with the overall map of the cemetery as shown to the right:


1. You can zoom in on any section of the map to see the details of the grave layout. The Lots are numbered, the graves are color coded, and the



trees, which can be labeled with their type, are shown.




2. The grave layout doesn't have to be rectangular; they can be curved to fit a road, or circular around a feature. The orange rectangles represent memorials which can be displayed pictorially.



3. Photos of features can be displayed by clicking on the hot-link feature with an icon. The display of these photos help keep people indoors in nasty weather and shows your features off to their best advantage, regardless of the conditions outdoors.



5. You can also have separate maps of each garden.

6. You can search for someone by lot owner or deceased name, property ID, or contract number. The Information Icon, as shown to the right, allows you to click on any space and display all of the pertinent information about the space.



Edward R. Orr
March 17 1914 - March 3 2009

Edward R. "Eddie" Orr, 94, of 2701 Tiara Strip, Bartonville and formerly of Gridley, died Sunday, May 3, 2009, at 7:10 pm at his residence in Bartonville. He had been in ill health for the past several months.

Eddie was born May 17, 1914 in Peoria, the son of Chester and Emily Kelly Orr. He married Erma Lindsey September 7, 1958 at the Westminster Presbyterian Church in Peoria. Surviving is his wife Erma and 2 daughters Janice Orr and Kellie Ferconio both of Orland park, 2 sisters Ruth Obert of Peoria and Lois Burke of Gridley and 2 grandchildren, Alex and Lindsey.

Eddie attended Lee Grade School in Peoria where he was active in sports and during his youth was active in the Boy Scouts of America. He graduated from Manual Training High School in 1933.

In 1934 he began a life-time interest in being a Ham Radio Operator and his call letters were W9LVU. After high school he went to work at Isaac Walker Hardware Co.

At age 27 he enlisted in the Army to serve his country. He was discharged in 1946 attaining the rank of Communications Sergeant. After the war Eddie joined his brother-in-law Harold Burke in opening the Gridley hardware Co. in Gridley, Ill. Later Eddie went to work for Isaac Walker and after that went to work as a purchasing agent for the Sherox Chemical Co. in Mapleton until his retirement.

He was a Fifty year member of the American Legion Post #218 in Gridley. Eddie was a 60 year member of the Masonic Lodge and the Scottish Rites Bodies, Valley of Peoria. He was a long-time member of the Westminster Presbyterian Church in Peoria.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, May 14, 2009 at the Endley Funeral Home in Bartonville. The Rev. Anna Saxon will officiate. Visitation will be one hour prior to the service. Burial will be in Lutheran Cemetery where military rites will be accorded by the Military Burial detail.

Memorials may be made to Hospice Compassus in Eddie's name or to the Shriners Hospital for Children.





10. All the above holds true for mausoleums and niches, too. The middle window in the locator to the right shows the top-view of the mausoleum overview.


Locator Map





11. Mausoleum walls can be mapped to provide a quick glance at availability; as a row fills up, it may be time to change prices.



12. Maps can be printed that show spaces put on reserve for a family.



13. The total value of your available inventory is always current and can be displayed in report format at any time. The left hand column identifies the garden or mausoleum of interest. The next two columns show the number of available spaces in that garden and their average value at today's prices. The final column lists the total valued of each garden/mausoleum/columbarium.

Finally, below that, the summary for the cemetery is provided. Bankers love this.
